Summer School 2017 – Guidelines

Welcome to Summer School, 2017!

Registration

- 1) Registration for all students begins on April 24th. Registration for credit acceleration courses closes on May 22nd. All registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Course enrollment is limited.
- 2) Students may sign up for 1 or 2 courses with two morning times available:
 - a) 8:00-9:55 a.m.
 - b) 10:05 a.m. -12:00 p.m.
- 3) Classes may be cancelled due to low enrollment. If classes are cancelled, students will be given the opportunity to sign up for another class that still may be open. All courses have enrollment caps.

Cost

There is no cost for summer school courses for currently enrolled Greenfield students (includes residents, current Chapter 220, and current open enrollment/tuition waiver students). There is a fee for bus transportation, if needed.

Attendance

- 1) Regular attendance is required.
- 2) Summer school begins Monday, June 19th and concludes on through Friday, July 28th. No classes will be held on Monday, July 3rd or Tuesday, July 4th.
- 3) **Summer school offers students an opportunity to earn credit within a condensed amount of time. Thus, absence of more than two (2) days from class, despite the reason, will result in the student being dropped from class with a failing grade. No credit will be given.** Sign up for courses should be aligned to students' summer schedule. If there are multiple days the student might miss, do not to sign up for courses during the summer session.
- 4) Parents are expected to phone the summer school high school office 281-6200 x2443 between 7:45 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. to report that their children will not be in attendance.
- 5) If a student misses a class and the school is not notified, parent contact will be made by telephone, email, and/or postal mail.
- 6) **Tardiness to class will count as one-half (½) day of absence.**
- 7) If the day of absence charged to the student's records for tardiness brings the student's total absence to more than **two (2) days**, he or she **will be dropped** from the class with a **failing grade** and **no credit** will be issued.

Transportation

- 1) Bus transportation will be available for students who reside in the Greenfield School District.
- 2) The cost is **\$133.88 per student** for the 6 week session.
- 3) Please complete the attached BUS TRANSPORTATION FORM and return form with a **separate check** made out to **FIRST STUDENT**. Please return complete form with check (payable to First Student) to the district office.

Grades

- 1) Mid-term progress reports will be given to each student during the week of July 10th.
- 2) Final grades will be mailed to the student's home address in August.
- 3) Letter grades will be assigned to courses and will impact overall high school GPA including class rank.

Additional Considerations

- 1) Students requiring courses for graduation not offered in the summer school program must discuss other credit acquisition options with their school counselor.
