


Who Are We?

Established in 1954, the School District of Greenfield is conveniently located within the City of Greenfield, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin.


Over 250 Professional Educators serve 3,600 students, in grades K4-12, in six (6) well-kept buildings:

Greenfield Schools are some of the most diverse schools in Wisconsin. Our diversity of backgrounds and experiences brings value to our educational environment.


