Epinephrine Pen for Emergency Use

Policy Statement:

The Epinephrine Pen for Emergency Use Policy and Procedure will be implemented by the School District of Greenfield staff to respond to an anaphylactic allergic reaction. The staff will receive an orientation devised by Safeschools which includes a video presentation and test, and in person hands-on training provided by the District Nurse of the School District of Greenfield. The District Nurse and Medical Director for the School District of Greenfield will review the policy and procedure on a yearly basis.

Purpose:

The stock Epinephrine Pen will be used to provide a bronchodilator to a person experiencing life-threatening anaphylaxis symptoms.

Objectives:

1. To assure that the Epinephrine Pen is appropriately administered by trained staff.
2. To make stock Epinephrine Pens available to anyone exhibiting life-threatening allergic symptoms who may or may not be aware of their insect or food allergy.
