#### World Cafe

The board heard from School Board members Julie DeGaro and Rob Hansen about the World Cafe held on December 17th. World Cafe conversations are designed to leverage the various relationships, ideas, and experiences of a large group in a flexible and solution-focused format. The large group was broken up into smaller table groups to have meaningful dialogue around key questions and new ideas about student well-being. There were 3 to 4 rounds of conversation with different table partners for each round. Upon the completion of each round, each table group was asked to document EVERYONE'S thoughts, ideas and suggestions on chart paper so that the information could be analyzed for reoccurring themes that will guide and inform our next steps to enhance student well-being at GHS.

## **Open Enrollment**

 The Board approves the allocation of 446 seats for the Wisconsin Open Enrollment Program in 2020-21.
Based on class size projections, this allocation will accommodate all students already attending the schools of the School District of Greenfield under the Open Enrollment Program.
