Overview:

Greenfield's High School Summer School Program provides students in grades 9-12 with opportunities to enhance their learning through **credit-earning** (for **incoming** 9^{th} , 10^{th} , 11^{th} and 12^{th} graders). Registration is first-come, first-served and will be open from February 26^{th} - March 22^{nd} . Early registration is strongly encouraged as all sections have a maximum number of participants.

GHS Hawks' Summer School offers students the opportunity to grow their learning during the summer months. An added benefit is the increased flexibility for course selections during the regular school year. Courses offered during the summer are the same courses offered as during the traditional school year. Successful completion results in students earning 0.5 credit per course.

This summer, for credit acceleration, we will offer (in-person): Physical Education 9, Health 9, Economics and Trigonometry. All courses have definite enrollment limits.

In order to meet the number of minutes needed to earn high school credit, according to the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, high school summer school will run from June 10th through July 25th. Classes will meet from 7:30 - 10:00 a.m. OR 10:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. MONDAY through THURSDAY (no school on Fridays or on Thursday, July 4th, in observance of Independence Day.

All courses will be in-person at Greenfield High School. Full attendance and participation is required to earn credit. Direct questions regarding course registration and requirements to each student's Counselor.
