- Referrals for preventive screenings (i.e. mammogram, colonoscopy, prostate cancer, bone density)
- Tobacco and alcohol cessation

Vaccines and Injections:

- Depo-Provera
- Gardasil

Medication:

- On-site dispensing of select medications
- Medication prescribing (sent to your preferred pharmacy)

* No narcotics are stored or dispensed in the clinic

Laboratory Testing:

- Select labs are drawn in the clinic and sent to our local laboratory
- Tests with immediate results during your visit include:
 - Glucose
 - Lipid panel (cholesterol, triglycerides)
 - Mononucleosis
 - Pregnancy
 - Strep throat
 - Urinalysis

If lab tests (or other medical services) outside of the scope of the clinic are needed, you may be referred to your primary care provider or a specialist for further evaluation.
