Who can use the clinic?

- All School District of Greenfield employees.
- Spouses and dependents ages 24 months and older who are enrolled in the District's health plan.
- Retirees of the District may use the clinic until age 65.
- Retirees' spouses (up to age 65) and dependents (up to age 26) who were enrolled in the health plan may use the clinic until the associated District retiree reaches 65 years of age.

Medication:

- On-site dispensing of select medications
