We are pleased the USDA has announced the extended of the Summer Food Service Program. The School District of Greenfield will be servicing FREE meals to all children 18 years old and younger until further notice.

Please visit <https://access.wisconsin.gov/access/> to see if you qualify for other benefits. With ACCESS, you can apply for state of Wisconsin benefits and programs in one place.

If your child is a student of the School District of Greenfield, we recommend that you fill out a Free and Reduced Meal Application. When Funding for the Free meal program runs out, all children with an approved meal application will continue to receive Free meals. If a child does not have a current application, they will be charged full price for meals. Applications can be completed at [myschoolapps.com](https://myschoolapps.com) or on the district website at <https://www.greenfield.k12.wi.us/> Click on Families and under Lunch Information will be the link to the meal application.

Free Meal Pickup will be held twice the week of September 14th.

**Pick-Up Days** will be **Monday, September 14th** and **Thursday, September 17th**

**Pick-Up Times** will be from **4:00pm - 6:00pm** each day

**Pick-Up Location** is **Greenfield High School** near Door 21, on the north side of building.

Monday's pick-up includes 3 days of meals and Thursday's pick-up includes 4 days of meals.

Starting **Monday, September 21st**, we will be back to just one pick-up a week which includes **7 days of free breakfast and lunch meals!!**

Pick-up EVERY Monday from 4:00pm to 6:00 pm at Greenfield High School's north parking lot.

Reminder, Meals are free for anyone 18 years old and younger and no ID is necessary.

If a neighbor or friend is unable to pick up meals for their children, you may pick up for them.
