### **Joint Statement of the School District of Greenfield and Greenfield Police Department**

*November 26, 2019*

Due to some irresponsible comments about a potential school shooting at Greenfield High School, the School District of Greenfield, in cooperation with the Greenfield Police Department, determined it was in the best interest of our school community to cancel classes today, November 26<sup>th</sup>.

The Greenfield Police Department thoroughly vetted the threat and found it was NOT credible, and the student admitted to making false statements. The Police Department is determining whether criminal charges are appropriate in this case, considering the significant disruption to the school community. The District appreciates the swift action taken by the Greenfield Police Department in investigating this threat and communicating with the District in a timely manner in order make informed decisions.

Based upon the information we have gathered, and the fact that it was not a credible threat, Greenfield High School will hold all afterschool activities this evening.
