#### **Meals during Ramadan**

The Food and Nutrition Department has applied for a waiver through DPI to support students participating in fasting during Ramadan. The waiver allows us to send meals home with these students at the end of the school day, February 17th to March 19th. The meals will include one breakfast and lunch that meets all of the school meal program guidelines. If a student participates in meal service during the day, they will not receive a second meal to take home. If you sign up for a meal, the student lunch account will be charged at the end of the day. Breakfast is free for all students, and Lunch is \$2.80 for elementary, \$3.00 for middle school, and \$3.10 for high school students. If you have been approved for free and reduced meals, you will not receive any charges for participating.
