● **Register online on Infinite Campus!!** The registration process is started by the parent/guardian through the Infinite Campus Parent Portal (School Store>GHS...Shop>Activity/Event Registration...Products). Once the

parent/guardian has completed/signed each form AND submitted payment, the student athlete must log into their IC account to sign their documents.

- ***Athletic Fee \$60.00.** The athletic fee must be submitted for the registration to be processed. If payment cannot be made online, cash or check(made out to GHS) can be brought to the GHS Main Office. If you are cut from a sport, please email Mrs. Shannon (sdentici@greenfield.k12.wi.us) for a refund.
- ***Physical performed 4/1/23 thru 3/31/24.** We must have Original Physical form (signed by the doctor) on file with GHS AND you must complete the Alternate Year Physical form online.
- ***Physicals performed 4/1/24 and forward.** You must submit a NEW Original Physical signed by the doctor.
