The 2026 GHS Prom will be held on Friday, May 1 at the Marcus Performing Arts Center - Bradley Pavilion. Messages will be sent later today to the parents/guardians of all juniors and seniors with the link to the Prom Application Google Form. **The Google Form must be submitted by your parent/guardian no later than Wednesday, April 8.** If you are bringing a guest that does not attend GHS OR if you are bringing a GHS freshman or sophomore as your guest, you must submit the paper guest application form that is located on the table outside of the attendance office. **Guest applications also must be received no later than April 8.**

After the application is received, attendance will be checked (see the Prom Overview for requirements). If approved, tickets will be made available for you to purchase through the Infinite Campus School Store. Tickets are \$85. **The final day to purchase your ticket will be on Friday, April 10.**

Prom Attendance

Interested in attending prom this spring? **Starting March 2nd and running through March 20th**, students who accumulate 12 or more tardies, unexcused absences, or trancies will not be eligible to purchase a prom ticket or attend as a guest at the GHS prom. Attendance matters, and being at school, in class, and on time is mandatory for students if they want to enjoy the upcoming prom experience.
