Pre-ACT Testing

On **Tuesday, April 9**, all 9th and 10th grade students will take the PreACT exam! Remember to bring your *fully charged, school-issued Chromebook*, a photo ID, pencils, and a calculator. You may also bring a snack for break time only since PreACT is strict about food and beverages during testing times. The school will not provide a snack for the PreACT. When testing is over, you may leave for the day or stay in the cafeteria, where lunches will be offered. Buses will arrive at 1PM for early dismissal. Juniors and seniors will have Tuesday off and are encouraged to use the day for postsecondary exploration.
