Are you ready to cheer on your classmates at upcoming games? Be sure you are on time to school and each class every day! Here are some important reminders about our attendance guidelines:

Any student with 12 or more tardies, truancies, or unexcused absences during the month will not be allowed to attend after-school events as a spectator until the following month*.

To help you stay on track, here's what to keep in mind when checking your attendance:

- Unexcused Tardies (which are marked UT): Means late to school without an excuse.
- Truancies (which are marked TR): Means missing school or class without a valid excuse, exceeding 10 absences, skipping an entire class, or missing 15+ minutes of a class.
- Tardies (which are marked T): Means late to class. These will show in grey for each class under your attendance tab. *Even if they're marked as "exempt," they still count towards event attendance.*

*ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES RELATED TO HOMECOMING:

The Homecoming football game will be held on October 3rd and the Homecoming dance will be held on October 4th. Attendance from 9/2 thru 9/25 will be used to determine eligibility to attend the Homecoming Game & Dance.
