- OCTOBER 10 conferences are from 8:00 to 11:00 am

To make an appointment for a virtual (Microsoft Teams) or in person conference, please use the [Fall Conferences Teacher Calendly Links](#) document. Here are the instructions on how to sign up using Calendly:

- Click the Calendly link for each teacher with whom you'd like to schedule a conference
- Select the desired date and time slot - in Calendly
- Complete the required items (parent/guardian name, student name, etc.)
- Add any additional information that you would like to provide
- *If an interpreter is needed, please complete that section and, if possible, sign up for TWO consecutive time slots to allow additional time for these services.*
- An email will follow confirming your time and the location of the conference (either room number or a Microsoft Teams link for the teacher).

Each conference should be limited to no more than 10 minutes (20 minutes with an interpreter) and staying on schedule is important to allow all families the opportunity to confer about their student. Please arrive on time to your conference and, if more time is needed, you and the teacher are encouraged to set up another meeting for a mutually agreeable time and day.
