The tool allows users to track credits, courses and assessments required for graduation. By reviewing the Academic Progress, parents, GHS staff and school counselors can see a student's progress towards meeting the requirements in a format that is easy and concise to follow.

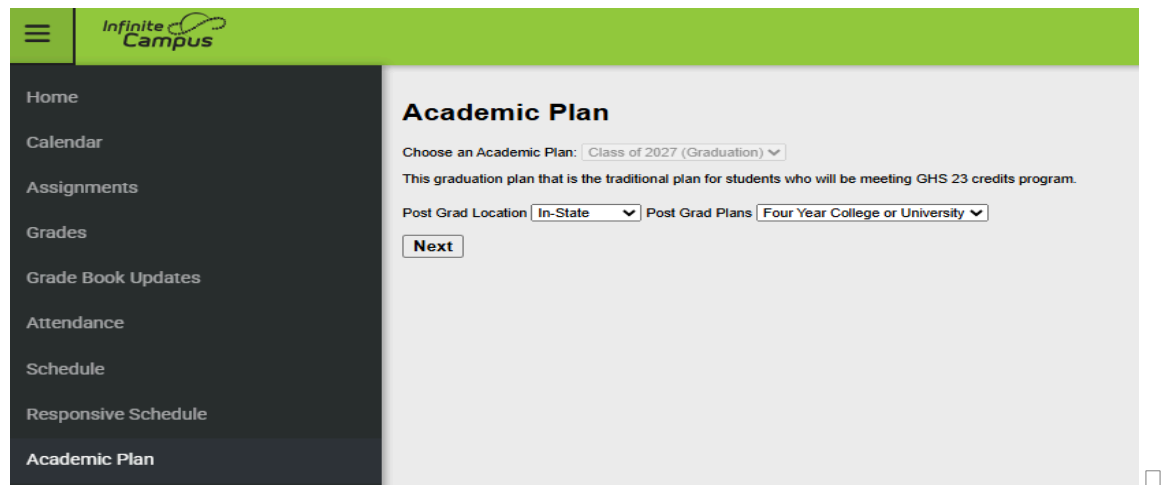

STEPS TO ENTER CLASSES INTO INFINITE CAMPUS:

1. Log in to Infinite Campus through your students account. **You cannot access this via the mobile app.** Use your student's chromebook if you do not have a computer at home.
2. Select **ACADEMIC PLAN**
3. Select **NEXT**



4. Your Academic Plan will display. Courses you are currently enrolled in, have previously taken, and are required to take will not be editable.
 - a. Warnings will display if Invalid Courses have been previously chosen. Select Continue at this point and make sure to adjust the 4-year plan accordingly.

 - b. Make sure to select Alternate course options.
 - c. When you are done selecting/verifying, be sure to **SAVE** the plan using the button on the top of the screen.

9. You can also do a general search of the Course Catalog at the top of the screen to add classes to your planner, either by name or course number. Search your course and then select it.
