**Step 2:** Each student and one parent/guardian will come to school a few minutes before your scheduled picture time and report directly to the **cafeteria** for pictures.

• If you park in the North Lot, please enter through Door #21. If you park in the South Lot please enter through Door #11.

**Step 3:** After your student is finished getting their picture taken, each student and one parent guardian should report to the **Hawk Dome** to pick up their required District Issued Chromebook and receive the necessary log-in information.

**Step 4:** Each student and one parent guardian will then head to the **New Gym** (*check out the new floor design*) and pick up the necessary books and materials per your student's schedule. Each table will be marked accordingly and staff will be on hand to assist when needed.
