- Lakeshore Learning

- Big Box Store items are typically not suitable for educational environments
- Standardization of existing furniture is preferred for maintenance repairs and transferability across the district based on needs

- School Specialty

- Homemade furniture is prohibited
- Rummage sale items are prohibited
- -Ensure that fabric furnishings meet the standards set by DSPS that require it to follow the NFPA Code 260 12.6.3.1, which states that fabric furnishings must pass an ignition test. The manufacturer should be able to provide documents that these items meet these requirements.
