Tickets: Tickets will be available for sale to all junior and senior GHS students <u>through Infinite Campus March 4</u> <u>through March 21</u>. Each junior or senior GHS student attending prom must have a completed ticket application submitted to the office for approval. You will find a Google Form application has been sent to your parents' emails. Junior and senior students can bring guests who are underclassmen at GHS or guests from other schools. Outside guests must either have approval from their school's administration or a background check must be completed. Underclassman guests and guests who do not attend GHS will have application forms to fill out available in the main office. Once applications have been processed (background checks for outside guests, obligations and attendance checks) student ticket(s) will be available to purchase on Infinite Campus. Remember, before students will be allowed to purchase a prom ticket, monetary holds on GHS student accounts must be paid. Please plan ahead- All paperwork must be in by March 18th, in order to process paperwork and make ticket(s) available for purchase by the March 21st deadline. Absolutley no tickets will be sold at the door.

Attendance Policy for Prom: Starting March 1st and running through March 21st, <u>students who accumulate 12 or</u> more tardies, unexcused absences, or truancies will not be eligible to purchase a prom ticket or attend as a guest at the GHS prom. Additionally, any student who purchases a ticket during this period but then accumulates 12 or more tardies, unexcused absences, or truancies from March 1st through the end of the school day on April 9th will not be allowed to attend prom, and their ticket cost will be refunded. Please note that Greenfield High School WILL NOT reimburse any other costs associated with attending prom, such as expenses for dresses, suits, transportation, or special appointments. **Prom:** This year's prom will take place at Baird Center Ballroom. Students should check-in for prom between 6:00 pm and 6:20 pm and present their <u>GHS school ID or driver's license when they check-in</u>. Guests of GHS students will need to present a school photo ID or a driver's license at the time of check-in.

Parking at Prom: The Baird Center is located in downtown Milwaukee. Students have the option to either find street parking or park in a lot. The lots listed below are all good options for students. Interstate Parking has issued a QR code for GHS prom attendees to receive 50% off the advertised parking rate when parking in a lot. Students should <u>enter at the North Building Main Entrance off of Kilbourn Avenue</u>. All guests will have to pass through a <u>metal detector in order to enter the building per building policy</u>.

Directions for QR Code at Kilbourn and Wells Street Entrance: Approach gate and scan QR pass. Pay the reduced rate. The gate will lift and you may park. Upon exit, scan the receipt you received at entry. The gate will lift and you are free to go!

Directions for QR Code at 330 Wells Garage: Approach gate and take a ticket. The gate will lift and you may park. Upon exit, scan the ticket received at entry followed by the discounted QR parking pass. Pay the reduced rate. The gate will lift and you are free to go!

Table Assignments for Dinner: Students will sign up for their dinner table in-person at GHS during lunch on Wednesday, April 02. Each table will seat 10 students.

Additional Information:

- 1. Each prom couple, consisting of two people, must include at least one person who is a junior or a senior at Greenfield High School.
- 2. Students must have fulfilled the Greenfield High School Attendance Requirements in order to purchase a ticket and attend prom.
- 3. All financial obligations must be cleared before tickets can be purchased.
- 4. If a student does not show up to prom and has purchased a prom ticket, a representative of GHS will be contacting their guardian to notify them of their student's absence.
- 5. All students and guests will be expected to be in attendance by 6:30pm, no one will be permitted in the event after this time. All attendees will be expected to remain at prom for the duration of the event and will only be permitted to leave in the event of an emergency, with a phone call made by a school administrator to a parent/guardian. <u>Attendees will be allowed to leave beginning at 10:00pm</u>, once students leave the prom, they may not return. It is parents/guardians responsibility to know where their child is going when prom is over, and to make expectations with regard to their behavior clear.
- 6. Alcoholic beverages, vaping, and smoking are not permitted at prom. Persons violating this rule will be removed from prom and ticketed. A breathalyzer device will be present and will be used if there is any suspicion of alcohol use. Bags and purses will be searched.
- 7. The prom will be chaperoned by GHS staff members.
