### State Honors Glenwood Elementary for Supporting All Learners

**GREENFIELD, Wis. — April 21, 2026—** The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction has named Glenwood Elementary a 2024-25 Wisconsin School of Recognition in the category of High Impact, a statewide award honoring public schools that demonstrate proven success in educating students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds.

State Superintendent Dr. Jill Underly notified Glenwood Principal Jenna Zizzo of the selection. The award focuses heavily on data and student outcomes, recognizing schools that successfully ensure socioeconomic barriers do not limit academic achievement.

The recognition reflects the direct work of the Glenwood teaching staff, support personnel, and families to close achievement gaps. Glenwood educators have focused on building rigorous, relevant learning opportunities that reach every student in the building, regardless of their background or resources.

“This honor belongs to our entire Glenwood community,” said Principal Jenna Zizzo. “Our staff works together to support students academically and socially, and our families are true partners in that work.”
