## What are the clinic hours?

The clinics are open seven days a week including most holidays.

## Do I need to schedule an appointment?

No appointments taken. Walk in during clinic hours.

## What lab testing can be done at the clinic?

- Influenza
- Mononucleosis
- Pregnancy test
- Strep throat test
- Urinalysis

## Who can use the clinic?

School District of Greenfield employees, spouses and dependents ages 18 months and up on the District's health insurance plan.

You must bring your health insurance card and photo ID with you to identify eligibility and to receive medical care at no cost.

## Is there a cost to use the clinic?

Participants on the District's health insurance plan have access to all services offered by the FastCare clinics at no cost. Your health insurance card and photo ID are required at the time of your visit.

## What kinds of services will be offered?

Diagnosis and treatment of non-emergent minor illnesses and injuries including but not limited to sore throats, ear aches, sinus infections, flu or cold symptoms, skin rashes, sprains/strains and pink eye.

## Who operates the FastCare clinics?

The clinics are operated and staffed by Froedtert & the Medical College of Wisconsin with a licensed, board-certified Advanced Practice Provider.

## Will my visits and personal health information be kept confidential?

Froedtert & the Medical College of Wisconsin is dedicated to protecting the privacy and security of your Protected Health Information by following the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) of 1996.

## Do I have access to my medical records after visiting the FastCare Walk-In Clinics?

To ensure continuity of care, the Froedtert & MCW FastCare clinics are linked to the electronic health record system serving the District's Workplace Clinic, physician offices, urgent care clinics, hospitals and emergency rooms of the Froedtert & MCW health network. However, FastCare services are open to all, not just Froedtert & MCW patients.

In addition, participants who visit a FastCare clinic, have the option to follow up at the District's Workplace Clinic.
