



Guidelines for Student Grant Applicants

Deadline: April 30th

Who can apply for Greenfield Foundation Grants?

Students seeking to participate in a learning opportunity which is beyond the general school day and supports the Greenfield School District educational program and related activities.

What kind of projects can be funded?

Innovative and creative learning opportunities which enhance the individual student learning experience. Student requests may include but are not limited to costs of supplies, materials, equipment, or travel expenses. The Greenfield Educational Foundation will not approve student pay requests.

How does one apply?

Applications for grants should be submitted to the Foundation no later than April 30th. The grant applications will be reviewed once all information is received.

A short application has been created for grant requests, which includes a description of the activity, mission of activity, goals and other objectives, activity design/timeline, and budget.

What criteria will be used to evaluate the applications?

Greenfield Education Foundation Board of Directors will review applications and make awards based on the potential impact on student learning, project design, number of students served, and value to the other students in the school district.
