## Important Free and Reduced Information during the government shutdown.

Families that have already qualified for free or reduced meals will continue to receive this benefit during the government shutdown.

Although SNAP benefits are suspended and new applications for SNAP benefits are not being processed, free and reduced meal applications can still be submitted and processed through the Greenfield Food Service Department.

Federal employees that have been furloughed or have a decrease in hours may submit a Free and Reduced Meal Application based on their current household income. This may be zero while in furlough. Once a family has been approved, meal benefits will continue throughout the school year.

Reminder, meal applications can be filled out at any time during the school year and as many times as they need, especially if there is a decrease in household income or increase in household size.
